**Declaration**

- I wish to make application for a licence to keep more than two dogs in accordance with clause 11 of the Ōpōtiki District Council [Dog Control Bylaw 2008](#).
- I agree to abide by the following conditions relating to the issue of the licence:  
 Minimum Standards for Accommodation of Dogs  
 Every dog owner must provide accommodation which meets the following minimum standards:  
 Weather-proof kennel or place of confinement in which there is sufficient room for the dog to stand up and turn around. Failure to keep a dog controlled or confined is an infringement and the owner may be fined.  
 The kennel or place of confinement must be:
- A solid structure sheltered from the elements, with a roof and floor and to be constructed on dry ground; and
  - Allow access to clean water at all times and be kept in a clean and sanitary condition.
  - The kennel must not be located nearer than 1 metre to any boundary of an adjoining property.
- The number of dogs on the premises shall NOT exceed the number permitted as indicated on the licence.  
 All deaths, sales or transfers of dogs, (including pups born on the premises) are to be notified to Ōpōtiki District Council within 14 days.
- I acknowledge that any breach of the Dog Control Act 1996 and the Ōpōtiki District Council Dog Control Bylaw 2008 may result in the cancellation of the licence if granted.

## The Ōpōtiki District Council Dog Control Bylaw 2008

### 11. Limit on Number of Dogs on a Premises

11.1 No more than two (2) dogs older than three months are permitted per dwelling in the following zones (except with a permit obtained from the Council):

- Residential Zone
- Mixed Activity Zone
- Ōhiwa Harbour Zone
- Coastal Settlement Zone
- There are no limits in the Rural Zone or Coastal Zone

Exceptions to this limit apply to boarding kennels, veterinary clinics and the Duke Street Pound.

11.1.2 The permit shall be in the form contained in the Second Schedule of this Bylaw and may contain such terms, conditions or restrictions as an authorised Officer of Council may deem fit to impose in any particular case.

11.1.3 If the permit is breached in any way it may be revoked by an authorised Officer of the Council at any time.
