## R 1 Guarantees to Sports Clubs and Others

Background	Sports clubs and other community organisations may require a guarantor when raising a loan.		
Purpose	To set out the criteria for the Council to be a guarantor.		
Policy Statement	That the policy decision in respect of guarantees for loans raised by sports clubs be:  (a) "That the Council shall only consider acting as guarantor in respect of the repayment of loans where:  (i) It has statutory powers to do so."  (b) That a clause be inserted in all future leases to read as follows:  "That in the event of the Club failing to meet its obligations in respect of any loan raised by the Club, the repayments of which have been guaranteed by the Council, the Council shall have the right to terminate this lease forthwith and all buildings erected on the land shall be delivered up to the Council and the Council shall not be liable to pay any compensation to the Club through any loss which the Club may sustain through such action on the part of the Council."
