It is my belief that this whenua should be handed over to the local hapu to manage and utilise as best as possible in whatever way is culturally sensitive and in a conservative restorative process. By this I mean, looking at protecting the environment by way of restoring natural native and fauna to the reserve, possibly creating walkways and story telling sites. I would also love to see our nearby URUPA extended to accommodate our whanau who not only live locally but those who still choose to come home for there last hoorah The urupa is generally used for hapu (Te Whanau a Nuku) however we have also welcomed many others to lie in rest.
