	The Te Arawhiti & Te Whānau a Apanui Joint Request for Ōpōtiki District Reserves must align with the resolution passed on 4 December 2021. It currently does not.
	All reserves must be returned to hapu/original land owners as Maori customary land and not under the Reserves Act or jurisdiction.
