### **Timeline**

### **Öpōtiki CBD upgrade**

- Several projects were identified in the 2018-28 Long Term Plan
- April 2020 application submitted to the PGF Fund
- August 2020 announcement that Council had been successful in our application to fund projects from the CBD and to revitalise the CBD
- October 2020 contract signed with Provincial Development Unit
- January 2021 Opotiki Town Centre Masterplan and Implementation Plan, adopted by Council


