The Ōpōtiki District Council Dog Control Bylaw 2008

- 11. Limit on Number of Dogs on a Premises
- 11. 1 No more than two (2) dogs older than three months are permitted per dwelling in the following zones (except with a permit obtained from the Council):
 - Residential Zone
 - Mixed Activity Zone
 - Ōhiwa Harbour Zone
 - Coastal Settlement Zone
 - There are no limits in the Rural Zone or Coastal Zone

Exceptions to this limit apply to boarding kennels, veterinary clinics and the Duke Street Pound.

- 11.1.2 The permit shall be in the form contained in the Second Schedule of this Bylaw and may contain such terms, conditions or restrictions as an authorised Officer of Council may deem fit to impose in any particular case.
- 11.1.3 If the permit is breached in any way it may be revoked by an authorised Officer of the Council at any time.
